24/03	<p data-bbox="400 327 791 360"><b>Local Strategic Partnership</b></p> <p data-bbox="400 365 1050 757">A detailed discussion took place on the new Local Strategic Plan which was announced at a meeting attended by our councillors and the police the previous day. The meeting was of the opinion that our basic structure covered the principles of the Local Strategic Plan but that we should seek to include other organisations within the meetings. Ideas put forward included Riviera Housing Trust, Devonshire and Westcountry Housing, Hookhills Community Centre and Paignton Zoo.</p> <p data-bbox="400 761 1050 909">The basic concept being that each areas LSP would provide the link between the Torbay LSP and through the correct structure it should open up avenues for funding within our area.</p>	
25/03	<p data-bbox="400 949 587 983"><b>Youth Issues</b></p> <p data-bbox="400 987 1050 1240">PC BARRETT explained that the summer had progressed reasonably well with few youth issues within the area. However, recently he has had problems in the areas at the rear of Roselands School and around the Kingsway Avenue area. Both these area are receiving attention as much as possible.</p>
