Improvements to Torbay's recycling
and waste services will start from
6th September 2010 and will include:

- a weekly kerbside recycling collection for all
- an increased range of recyclable materials collected so you can recycle up to 85% of your waste
- a new weekly kitchen waste recycling collection
- new recycling containers for better and more flexible recycling storage
- same day recycling and residual waste collections for the majority of residents
- an increased range of materials collected from flats, including kitchen waste
- fortnightly residual waste collections for those with space for a residual wheelie bin

Look out for letters, leaflets and calendars with further details about your new services, as well as roadshows, talks and door-to-door canvassers, between July and October 2010. There will also be information in the Torbay Council magazine, Torbay View.



TOR2 is a newly formed Joint Venture Company which will deliver service improvements and value for money to Torbay residents. Torbay Council has chosen to partner May Gurney because of their sustainable business approach which will lead to a 30,000 tonne reduction in carbon per annum; the equivalent of taking 10,000 cars off the road. They offer innovative and integrated services with significant benefits to Torbay including new employment opportunities and savings of £10m over 10 years.

TOR2 will provide Torbay and its residents with a first-class waste service to ensure Torbay can achieve and comfortably exceed its recycling target of 50% by 2012. Torbay's current recycling rate is 35.7%.
